OFFICERS' MEETING

October 3, 2012 Martinson Avenue Christian Church, Wichita, Ks

19 members attended: 11 officers/deputies/champions; 2 event stewards; 3 members of the populace; one infant

Planning for January Coronation here continues. No site token ideas have been received. The armory of the Royal peers was suggested. A possible Valor theme plan was offered by Ld. Johann to any interested members bidding to organize this event.

Exploration Place has extended an invitation to hold indoor fighter practice at their location during cold weather. They also requested the monthly presentations be done during the coming year. HE Sir Wulfric is organizing the Home Show demonstration October 20th- 21st at Century II and needs people interested in dancing and fighting to contact him. Ly. Yukiko proposed a presentation at McConnell Air Base for on base personnel in the Spring. It was tentatively approved.

The Herald's office reported several local proposals are in process. Both Web Minister Sung and Chronicler Saki requested to be updated on officer and interest group contact information and any schedule changes so they can be on the official site and in the *Dragonflyre*. 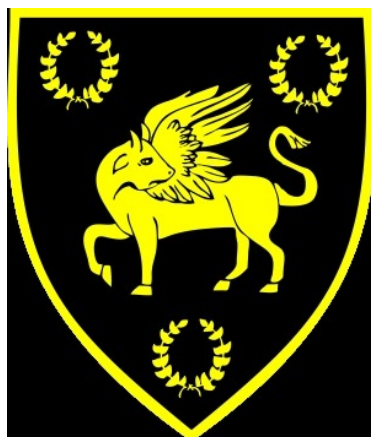
